





This road map carries a picture guide to some of the most interesting points to visit while touring the beautiful state of Oklahoma.


























- PIONEER WOMAN MONUMENT, A-9 Ponca City's most prized monument is the Pioneer Woman Monument which symbolizes the courage and determination on the part of the women and children to endure the vast wilderness of the frontier.
- FORT GIBSON STOCKADE, C-11 The stockade was the first army fort in Oklahoma which was built in 1824 at Fort Gibson, Oklahoma. Originally built as a frontier army post, it has now been restored exactly as it was at that time.
- WILL ROGERS MEMORIAL, B-11 Upon entering the Memorial you will find the "Equentrian Bronze" of Will Rogers and his horse, Soapsuds. The Memorial near Claremore contains the bronze statue of Will, made by Jo Davidson, the tomb where Will, his wife and infant son are buried, and trophies and honors bestowed on him.
- **PLATT NATIONAL PARK WILDLIFE, E-9** Here you will be astonished to discover buffaloes grazing in the pasture of the park. It is advised not to get too close to these animals since they are wild and should be treated with caution.
- PLATT NATIONAL PARK, E-9 Platt National Park is well-known for its healthful mineral waters. Located in the park is the "Name Your Brand Water Fountain" which allows you a choice of city water, Bromide Spring mineral water, or Medicine Spring mineral water. Bromide and Medicine Springs issue from the base of Bromide Cliff.
- WICHITA MOUNTAINS, E-7 The Wichita Mountains is an impressive range of mountains located north of Lawton. Among these majestic mountains that rise conspicuously above their surroundings is Mt. Scott which overlooks the picturesque Medicine Lake.
- BLACK MESA STATE PARK, A-1 The Black Mesa is Oklahoma's newest state park. In this park you will discover many beautiful scenes, but most spectacular are the unusual rock formations, Indian pictographs and Dinosaur pits. This state park also has an attactive trout-stocked lake.
- INDIAN CITY U.S.A., D-7 Indian City is located near Anadarko. Every summer indian drums sound across the plains in Oklahoma when indian festivals and ancient rituals bring back the pageantry of years past.
- TURNER FALLS, E-9 Southern Oklahoma's Arbuckle Mountains form the setting for the state's most spectacular waterfalls, Turner Falls. These beautiful 72-foot falls attract many visitors each year.
- STATE CAPITOL BUILDING, C-8 The Oklahoma Capitol is the only domeless state capitol and the only capitol in the fifty states that has producing oil wells on capitol grounds. Not far from the capitol building stands the "Liberty Bell" of Oklahoma City.
- FRONTIER CITY U S A, C-8 Its old-fashioned buildings, saloons, shops, gunslingers, eccentric oil-wells turn the pages back to the 1800's. There are picturesque sights around every corner. Frontier City consists of six square blocks of an authentic recreation of a lusty, colorful frontier community.

HISTORICAL POINTS OF INTEREST



## BLACK KETTLE MUSEUM, C-5 — was built two miles from the site of the Battle of Washita in which the Cheyenne chief, Black Kettle, fell before General Custer's Troops. SITE OF OLD CHEROKEE INDIAN NATIONAL CAPITOL, C-12 — Here can be found the Indian Museum, a Cherokee Weavers shop and the Murrell Mansion with period furnishings and historical exhibits.

- CREEK INDIAN NATIONAL COUNCIL HOUSE AND MUSEUM, C-10 is a National historic landmark. FORT RENO, C-7 — was established in 1874 to protect the Chisholm trail. The first telephone line in Oklahoma was stretched between the fort and the Darlington Indian Agency.
- GOLDA'S OLD MILL (BITTING SPRINGS MILL), C-12 130 years old; this historic grist mill is still grinding corn.
- PAWNEE BILL'S HOME, B-9 ranch house of the old west showman was built in 1903. Here can be seen many fine western paintings and personal collections of Pawnee Bill and his wife.
- SEQUOYAH'S HOME, C-12 famous Cherokee Indian scholar who developed the Cherokee alphabet.
- WILL ROGERS BIRTHPLACE SITE, B-11—on the shore of Oologah Reservoir is proposed to be designated as an Oklahoma state park.
